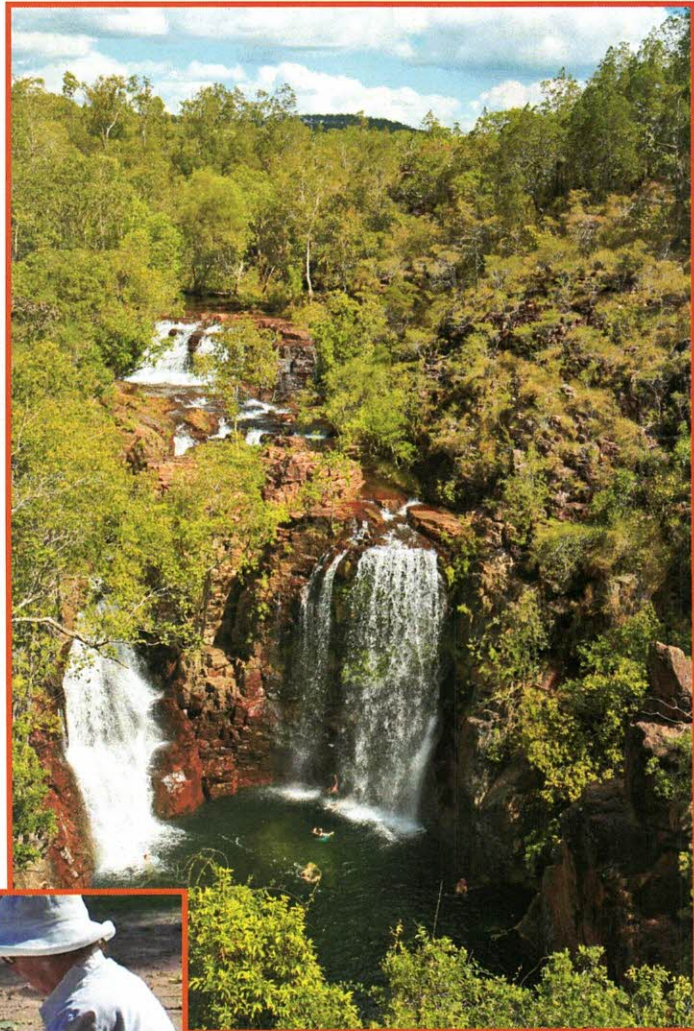
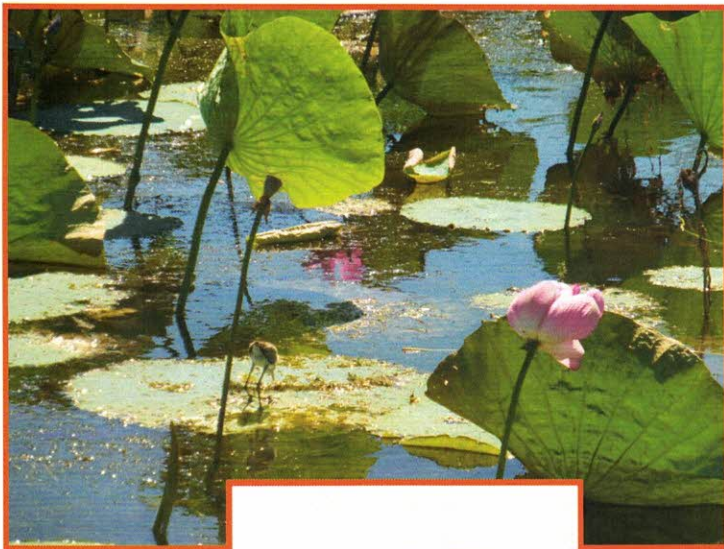
Kakadu and Litchfield National Parks with Leonie Norton

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Itinerary

Day 1 Mon - Meet and Greet

You will be met at Darwin airport around midday by your Aussie Redback Tours team. We head straight to Adelaide River and Mount Bundy Station to check in to our accommodation for the next three nights. Once settled, we'll enjoy pre-dinner drinks and nibbles with Leonie and fellow artists and travelers. (D)

Day 2 Tue—Litchfield National Park

This morning we drive into Litchfield National Park, home to waterfalls, termite mounds and The Lost City. We'll spend time at Florence Falls and Wangi Falls where Leonie will show you how she captures the sights around her, and then it will be your turn to do the same till it's time to pack up and head back to our accommodation at Mt Bundy Station for dinner and a good night's rest. 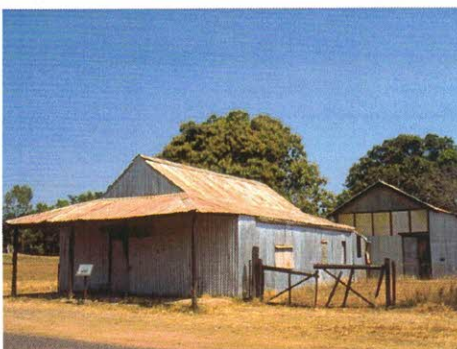


Day 3 Wed—Mount Bundy Station

We spend today Mount Bundy Station which sits on the banks of the Adelaide River. The tranquil surrounds give you endless sketching choices. Choose from two billabongs, the river, majestic hills, savannah-type plains and grasses, cattle, horses, donkeys, a pig, water buffalo, many species of birds and fish, old cars and tractor, and the cottages and homestead that were the houses from the original station. Leonie will start you off with some invaluable tips on how to capture individual scenes, and soon after you'll be off to find your own special place to sketch, stopping for a bite to eat around lunch time. Day 4 Thu—Pine Creek



We head to Katherine via Pine Creek today, stopping for morning tea, lunch, and a sketching opportunity in the historic area of Pine Creek. The town itself offers some lovely sketching opportunities too, such as The Railway Station Museum, and the Ah Toy Bakery (pictured), and with Leonie's guidance, you should be able to capture a record of the day in your sketchbooks. Later we continue down the road to our accommodation in Katherine (our home for two nights). (B,D)
